Mentor Program

A Child Mentor Program is available to children of Skilled Migrants offering assistance and support in areas of homework and reading, or other challenging activities, as well as sport and leisure.

Volunteers are appropriately trained and registered with particular skills and abilities to support children and are required to undergo police checks and mandatory notification training.

Additional programs are running daily for English conversation for adults.

Orientation Service

Group and one on one support are available to introduce migrants to all the key agencies and facilities in the Limestone Coast Region. Written materials are also available.
